COVE WALK: 3 to 5 PM Sunday, July 21, meeting at the steps of Strong Cottage at KBIA. \$10 per family; open to the public.


OPEN SAIL/KAYAK: 9 AM to 1 PM Sunday, July 21; free and open to members.
