

At noon, we will serve up a barbecue lunch of hot dogs, cheeseburgers or veggie burgers, lemonade, iced tea, chips,




potato salad and cake. KBIA ribbons, wedges and plaque honors will be announced at 1 PM. We hope you'll join us for this festive summer finale!
